The Adopt-A-Highway Program

The Caltrans Adopt-A-Highway Program provides a way for groups to help maintain and improve the California Highway System. Groups have the option to adopt a stretch of highway for a period of time.

The Adopt-A-Highway program, which began in 1973, has helped clean and enhance over 15,000 miles of highway.

Participation can include one or more of the following activities:

- Removing litter (work frequency varies)
- Planting and establishing trees or wildflowers
- Removing graffiti.
- Controlling vegetation.

Adoptions usually span a two-mile stretch of highway.

The Adopt-A-Highway Program is not a for-profit program and is managed by Caltrans.
